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New Features in SecureDomino R7.0

➤ **Designated (SPNEGO) Server Authentication**

Allows leveraging the new Lotus Domino 8.5.1 Feature SPNEGO on earlier Domino Releases and on machines running other operating systems than Windows. Requires you to run at least one dedicated and SPNGEO activated authentication host on a Windows machine.

➤ **Advanced Logon Hours Definition**

Allows to change the scope of a logon hour definition. One operational mode enables you to generally allow logon, but prevent logon on selected days for the time period defined, while the other operational mode generally prevents login but allows it during defined time periods.

➤ **Password Request Encryption**

Sending a new password to a user can now be done via encrypted mail. This contributes to even more secrecy in the organization and enables you to achieve compliance with corporate IT guidelines.

➤ **Updated Redirection Mapping**

The Redirection Mapping shortcuts now contain a more current list of available Domino URL Commands

➤ **Improved performance**

Performance improvements have been made in the configuration database as well as in the DLL, leading to an even better user experience.

➤ **Support for IBM Lotus Domino R 8.5.1**

SecureDomino 7 now supports IBM Lotus Domino R 8.5.1.
